Anglican Care Waiapu's vision is to create thriving communities where caring and learning for life are at the heart of our Christian values.

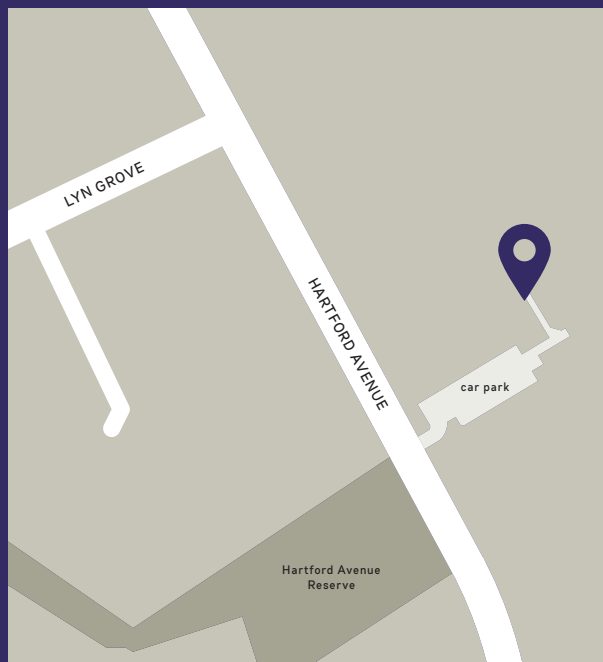
