The Kauri Centre's daily activity programmes in Te Puke and Papamoa specifically meet the needs of our senior community who require a place to go for support, friendship, encouragement and new opportunities.

We facilitate enjoyable activities to actively encourage and inspire our clients to explore new opportunities and develop wider friendships, and we also provide assistance when required. This may be as an advocate, offering information and practical help, or an understanding ear.

The Kauri Centre also provides time out for families, secure in the knowledge that they can leave their loved one with us for the day in an enjoyable, safe and caring environment.

## What we offer

The Kauri Centre in Papamoa is open Monday, Tuesday and Friday, and Te Puke is open Wednesday and Thursday. Each week, our clients enjoy a range of social activities and entertainment to maintain an active mind and body and encourage social interaction.

Our programme includes:

- Scenic trips and picnics
- Social activities
- Housie and crosswords
- Sing-a-longs
- Gentle exercise to music
- Guest speakers and entertainers
- Creative projects

Morning and afternoon tea and a nutritious lunch are provided.

A quiet room is available for clients who may need rest and privacy during the day.

A door-to-door transport service is available to most clients in the local area. Assistance and information may be provided to assist others with alternative transport needs.

## Referral service

The Kauri Centre serves to complement the role of families and existing services, therefore we are happy to meet with individuals and families to discuss their needs and the options available at the centre.

## Costs

To make our service affordable, we endeavour to keep client costs to a minimum. Clients may be entitled to a subsidy from Support Net.

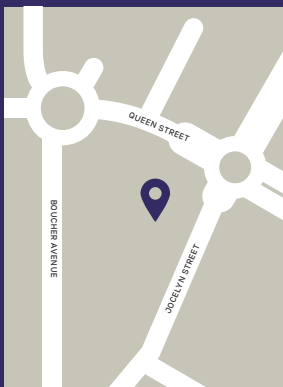
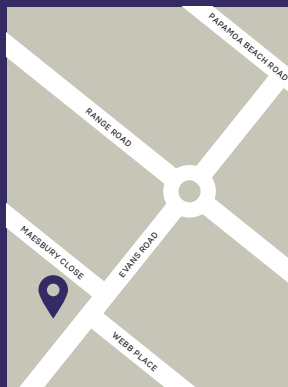
Bookings are essential to secure a place in our Centre's daily activities.
